Schedule

Classes are offered during the weeks of:

June 9-13, June 16-20, June 23-27

July 7-11, July 14-18, and July 21-25

Classes meet Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

Extended Care

Hours are 12:00 until 6:00. Bring a packed lunch with a drink if staying for Extended Care.

Registration/Tuition/Fees

The registration deadline is one week prior to each class. The cost per week is \$60 per child, with some classes having a materials fee, which is listed inside this brochure. Class sizes remain small so early enrollment is advised. Classes below the minimum enrollment will be cancelled and a refund will be issued. Pre-school age children **MUST** be potty-trained to attend classes.

Extended care fees will be charged at a rate of: \$20.00 per day for first child, \$15.00 per each additional child or \$4.00 per hour.

Payment/Refunds

Payment is due in full at the time of registration. We accept cash and checks only. Refunds will be given only if requested in writing one week prior to the start date of class. Twenty percent of the tuition is non-refundable. Material fees are non-refundable. Refunds are not given for absences.

Arrival/Departure

Students are expected to arrive by 9:00AM and be picked up on time at 12:00 noon. Students not picked up by noon will go to Extended Care at an additional fee.

Snack

Snack time is given each day. Students should bring their own snack.

Additional Information

Prior to the start of classes, a confirmation call will be made to each family. Since changes in teacher availability and enrollment levels are possible, Ashley Academy reserves the right to make schedule changes if necessary. We will inform you of any changes.
