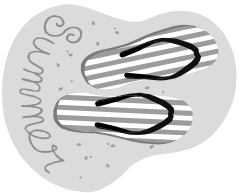

Extended Care

Extended Care is offered each day following camp. It begins at 12:00 noon and runs until 6:00 PM. The cost is \$20 per day. Each additional child in the family costs \$15. Children who need occasional after-camp care may stay in extended care for a portion of the afternoon at a rate of \$4 per hour per child. Children who are not picked up by 6:00pm will be charged a penalty of \$1 per minute. All payments for extended care services are expected to be paid at the end of each week.

Children who stay for extended care need to bring a sack lunch and drink each day. No food will be provided by the school. Lunch will usually begin right after camp has ended at noon.

There will be themed activities planned for each day of the week. There will also be a quiet time designated each day for our younger campers. If you wish to send items for rest time, please make sure they are labeled with the child's name.

Daily Schedule:

12:00—1:00 Lunch and free play (on playground or in gym)

1:00—2:00 Quiet Time (rest, puzzles, books, etc.)

2:00—5:00 Daily Theme Activities (see below)

5:00—6:00 Free play

Marvelous Monday: movies and more

Terrific Tuesday: arts & crafts

Wacky Wednesday: water day

Thrilling Thursday: games & puzzles

Fantastic Friday: show & tell day (campers get to bring one item for this activity)

Schedule

Classes will be offered during the weeks of June 8-12, June 15-19, June 22-26, July 6-10, July 13-17, and July 20-24. Classes meet from 9:00 AM—12:00 noon Monday—Friday. More information about extended care is listed after the camp descriptions.

Registration/Tuition

The registration deadline is one week prior to each class. The cost per week is \$65 per child, with some classes having a materials fee (it is listed with the class details). Class sizes do remain small, so early enrollment is advised. Classes below the minimum enrollment will be cancelled and a refund will be issued.

****Preschool children MUST be potty-trained to attend camp.**

Payment/Refunds

Payment is due in full at the time of registration. We accept cash and checks only. Refunds will be given only if requested in writing one week prior to the start date of class. Twenty percent (20%) of the tuition is non-refundable. Materials fees are non-refundable. Refunds are not given for absences.

Arrival/Departure

Students are expected to arrive by 9:00AM and be picked up on time at 12:00 noon. All children not picked up by noon will go to Extended Care and will be charged the additional fee.

Snack

Snack time is given each day. Students should bring their own snacks.
