Summer Enrichment 2010 Details

Schedule

Classes will be offered during the weeks of June 7-11, June 14-18, June 21-25, July 5-9, July 12-16, and July 19-23. Classes meet from 9:00 AM—12:00 noon Monday—Friday. More information about extended care is listed after the camp descriptions.

Registration/Tuition

The registration deadline is one week prior to each class. The cost per week is \$75 per child, with some classes having a materials fee (listed with the class details). Class sizes do remain small, so early enrollment is advised. Classes below the minimum enrollment will be cancelled and a refund will be issued.

****Preschool children MUST be potty-trained to attend camp.**

Payment/Refunds

Payment is due in full at the time of registration. We accept cash and checks only. Refunds will be given only if requested in writing one week prior to the start date of class. Twenty percent (20%) of the tuition is non-refundable. Material fees are non-refundable. Refunds are not given for absences.

Arrival/Departure

Students are expected to arrive by 9:00AM and meet their camp teacher in the gym each day. The teacher will escort the children to their classroom. Children are expected to be picked up by noon and will be dismissed from the gym. All children not picked up by noon will go to Extended Care and will be charged the additional fee.

Snack

Snack time is given each day. Students should bring their own snacks and drinks.

Additional Information

Prior to the start of classes, a confirmation call and/or email will be made to each family. Since changes in teacher availability and enrollment levels are possible, Ashley Academy reserves the right to make schedule changes if necessary. We will inform you of any changes. Extended Care

Extended Care is offered each day following camp, which begins at 12:00 noon and runs until 6:00 PM. The cost is \$20 per day. Each additional child in the family costs \$15. Children who need occasional after-camp care may stay in extended care for a portion of the afternoon at a rate of \$4 per hour per child. Children not picked up by 6:00 PM will be charged a penalty of \$1 per minute. All payments for extended care services are expected to be paid at the end of each week.

Children who stay for extended care need to bring a sack lunch and drink each day. No lunch food will be provided by the school. Lunch will usually begin right after camp has ended at noon.

There will be themed activities planned for each day of the week. There will also be a quiet time designated each day for our younger campers. If you wish to send items for rest time, please make sure they are labeled with the child's name.

1:00—2:00 Quiet Time (rest, puzzles, books, etc.)

5:00—6:00 Free play
